




AGE, GENDER & HEALTH OF DTC CLIENTS




70% of participants are homeless at entry to DTC · 90% test as high—very high risk to reoffend · more than half of DTC participants have a mental health diagnosis

DTC SUCCESS AND GRADUATION RATE



In order to graduate from DTC, participants must:

- have suitable and stable housing,
- be involved in pro-social community activities such as work, school, or volunteerism,
- not have accrued any new charges or convictions,
- have demonstrated compliance with release conditions,
- been abstinent from all mood-altering chemicals, as verified by urine drug testing, for not less than the last 180 days (level I) or 90 days (level II).
